Dr. Hasan Ali Khan is Assistant Professor in the School of Arts, Humanities, and Social Sciences at Habib University, Karachi. He obtained his doctorate from the School of Oriental and African Studies (SOAS), University of London, in the Study of Religions. His book, *Constructing Islam on the Indus: The Material History of the Suhrawardi Sufi Order, 1200–1500 AD*, published recently by Cambridge University Press is an adaptation of his doctoral thesis. In addition, he is the author of a number of published and forthcoming book contributions and articles. He has worked on research projects, which include the religious beliefs of the Hindu community of Tharparker in southern Pakistan, which are unique, and the history and culture of the city of Sehwan Sharif with the French Interdisciplinary Mission based at the Centre for South Asian Studies (CNRS-EHESS). His current research interests are in the Alevi community of Turkey and the Ahl-I Haqq of Iran. He is also involved in research on the Rifa'i Sufi Order, prevalent amongst the coastal Baluch in Pakistan.
